# Update on school closure

At the time of this publication, the information from the State is that schools may resume on-site instruction after April 24. That means we are currently operating with the assumption that school will resume in our building on April 27, unless Governor Evers announces another plan. We realize there are now more than 20 other states that have determined they will close school for the remainder of the year and that the absence of a confirmed reopening date leaves some uncertainty for all of us.

As a staff, we have discussed long-range planning to last through May 22, if necessary. We will remain committed to supporting our families through this time and will continue offering online learning opportunities for students as long as we need to. If we are allowed to hold operations on site at any point this school year, we will follow the safety guidance of the local public health officials.

As always, we encourage families to stay informed, ask questions if you are struggling or unsure about academic expectations for your child, and let us know how we can best support your family through this trying time.

May He continue to bless both our school and St. John's by keeping us firm in His Word and mission to "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all the nations."


