- 2) Select "Students" under the School drop-down menu.
- 3) Select the Academic tab.
- 4) Click the arrow symbol (>) next to Report Cards to expand the area.
- 5) Click the PDF symbol to preview the report card. (If you would like a hard copy of your student's report card, print it from here.)
- 6) Click the "Acknowledge" button under the statement "I acknowledge viewing this report card" to let your child's teacher know that you've seen the report card.
