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Sign up for Parent-Teacher Conferences

Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held on Tuesday, February 27. We will not have school that day to accommodate for these important meetings. If you need to bring your child, please bring an

activity to keep him/her busy while you meet with the teacher. Older children may wait quietly in the hallway outside the classroom.

The links to sign up are available for students in 4K - 8th grade. The link for Pre-K3 is coming soon. We will email Pre-K3 families when the sign-up is available. For children in grades Pre-K3 – 4th grade, parents will complete a separate form for each child. For children in middle school (5th – 8th grades), parents will select one slot per family.

Sign up to meet with your child's teacher using the following steps:

- 1) Log in to Educate. (Contact Stacy Bernd if you need your login credentials.)
- 2) Locate the link titled "Parent-Teacher Conference Sign-Ups" under the Announcements area, then click "(more...)" to expand the information.
- 3) Locate the appropriate conference sign-up*. (If the link doesn't work, copy and paste it into your browser or try using a different device.)
- 4) Complete the form.
- 5) Click submit. Any change to your selected slot needs to be done PRIOR to 3 PM on Monday (2/26) by contacting <u>Dana Veers</u>. Last minute cancelations should be communicated in an email to your child's teacher.
- * The middle school teachers will each have a table set up in the gym. Your family will sign up for one 30-minute slot, no matter how many middle school students you have in your family. You can go to whichever and however many middle school teacher tables you would like within your one timeslot. This will allow you to speak to more than one teacher and especially a teacher where you feel there are specific conversation needs. In addition, Meredith Pucci, Valerie Weiss, Levi Schriefer, and Sue Martalock will be in the building that day. - Clothing showing cleavage, stomach, shoulders, collarbone, and/or back.
- Dresses, jumpers, skirts, or skorts shorter than fingertip length.
- Skirts, dresses, or jumpers without tights, leggings, or shorts underneath.
- Sleeveless dresses or jumpers without a shirt underneath.
- Clothing containing language and/or images that could be construed as offensive or inappropriate.
- · Clothing containing holes or frayed cuffs.

Federal EIN: 39-1437079

Tax season is upon us. You will need our Federal EIN: 39-1437079. Also, you can find a record of your tuition expenses for 2023 using the following steps:

- 1. Log into TADS.
- 2. Navigate to the Billing area.
- 3. Select the number in blue next to the 2022-23 school year.
- 4. Click on the Reports tab.
- 5. Click on the link titled "Household Paid Tuition Tax Report".
- 6. Enter "2023" in the Tax Year field.
